#### **BETTY ANN PENICK'S CORN PUDDING**

*Here is a simple, favorite recipe, even my 2 children could make:*

3 one-pound cans whole corn, drained 1/4 cup flour 1/4 cup sugar 1 tsp salt  
1/4 tsp pepper 2 beaten eggs 2 Tble butter, melted 1-1/2 cups milk

Combine all in casserole dish. Bake 1 hour @ 325 degrees; or 20 minutes in microwave, stirring occasionally. Can be prepared in 15 minutes.
